The Battle of Dukla Pass, is perhaps the largest battle you may never have heard about. Fought in the fall of 1944, it raged for 50 days destroying entire villages and killing tens of thousands of young soldiers. The fighting occurred in a region predominantly populated by Rusin villages. At one time 60% of the First Czechoslovak Army was Rusin.

This presentation will provide a broad overview of the military and historical events, but the primary focus is to "put a face on the events" of 1944, with eyewitness stories from survivors.



Bill Tarkulich, a member of the New England Chapter of the Carpatho-Rusyn Society, lives in Lexington Massachusetts. His Grandparents immigrated from the Eastern Slovakia villages of Zboj and Nova Sedlica. While Mr. Tarkulich's primary research area is genealogy, with nearly no English-language information and conflicting opinions he was driven to flush out the facts of this event. Mr. Tarkulich has given this presentation to the New Jersey, Connecticut and Pittsburgh chapters of the Carpatho-Rusyn Society.
